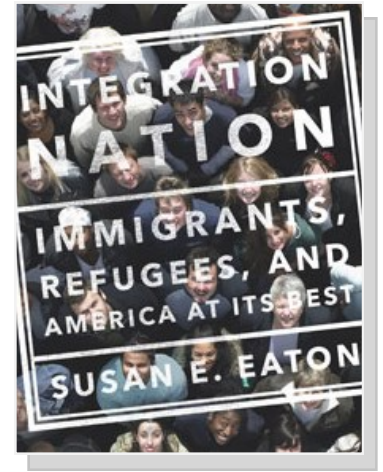


INTEGRATION NATION
